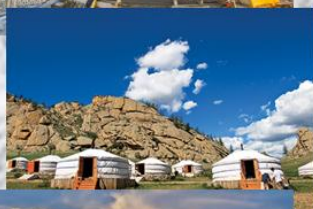

AUG 08 (TUE) MANILA / ULAANBAATAR, MONGOLIA

Depart Manila via Beijing for Ulaanbaatar.

Arrive in Ulaanbaatar, the capital of Mongolia. We'll be greeted at the airport and escorted to our hotel.

AUG 09 (WED) KHOGNO KHAN MOUNTAINS

(B,L,D)

After breakfast, we commence our Mongolia adventure with a 5-hr drive to the Khogno Khan Mountain, a massive series of rocky hills that rise out of an otherwise flat landscape. Marvel through the amazing scenic views of rolling grasslands and vast sand dunes and the occasional sightings of traditional ger (yurts) on the way. Sweat a little by hiking to a height of nearly 2000 meters for an incredible view of the grasslands (an optional 2-hump camel ride is possible). Overnight in Ger Camp

AUG 10 (THU) KHARKHORIN / ULAANBAATAR

(B/L/D)

Early drive to Kharkhorin. Visit the Kharkhorin Museum and Erdene-Zuu, a monastery with 108 stupas. This is the first Mongolian Buddhist monastery built in 1586 by the order of Abtai Sain Khan. Explore the ruins of this great Mongolian Capital City. After lunch, drive back to Ulaanbaatar for rest and overnight.

AUG 11 (FRI) ULAANBAATAR / KHUSTAI NATIONAL PARK

(B,L,D)

After breakfast, proceed to the central square of Ulaanbaatar, Chinggis Square. See the Parliament House, National Museum of Mongolia and the Gandan Monastery where we see the huge gold plated Buddha - a symbol of Mongolian national pride and cultural revival. After lunch, drive to Hustai National Park. See Takhi, the Asian wild horse (Przewalsky breed). Then proceed to the Mongol Nomadic Tourist Camp (with private bathroom). Enjoy a Mongolian traditional meal of "Horhog". Overnight in Ger Camp.

AUG 12 (SAT) ULAANBAATAR CITY TOUR

(B/L/D)

Today, we will take part in the everyday life of a traditional Mongolian family. Witness the breeding of five kinds of livestock and their travel from one place to another using the ox, yak, camel and horse carts. See how dairy products are made and be able to taste some. Watch a demonstration of milking yaks and mare, fastening and milking of sheep and goats, as well as felt tanning. Then drive back to Ulaanbaatar. Go to Shijiamoni Buddhism Park and Zaisan Hill. The huge monument on the top of the hill was created as a memorial to the soldiers who died in World War II. This hill gives one the best panoramic view of Ulaanbaatar and its surrounding sacred mountains. In here, also sits a 23 meter tall statue of Buddha. Next stop will be Bogd Khan Palace, a series of beautiful traditional buildings, where the last religious King of Mongolia resided. In the evening, we put our hands together for Tumen Ekh - a national ensemble of Mongolian traditional songs and musical instruments, such as Morin Khuur, throat singing and many more.

AUG 13 (SUN) 13TH CENTURY PARK / GENGHIS KHAN STATUE

(B/L/D)

Drive to the 13th Century Park, and explore various Ger camps, farms, statues and traditional entertainment areas all in real lifestyle of the 13th century era. In this place, rule of law is strong. There is no electricity and telephones are not allowed, so that one can experience how it was back then. Enjoy craftsmen at work, see Mongolian calligraphy, learn to write Mongolian traditional scripts, ride horses and camels or simply sit back and enjoy the beautiful landscapes of the countryside and the clear blue sky. After lunch, proceed to the impressive 45m tall Giant Genghis Khaan Statue, then transfer to the "Gorkhi-Terelj" National Park.

AUG 14 (MON) ULAANBAATAR

(B/L/D)

This morning, marvel at the 'Three Friends Cave' and Turtle Rock. Cap this day with a visit to a Mongolian nomadic family. After lunch, there is time to do some shopping at the State Department Store and Cashmere World. Overnight in a Ger Camp.
