APR 02 (SUN) OSAKA CITY TOUR (B/L/D)

After breakfast, explore Osaka Castle one of the most famous landmarks in Japan. Then on to the new garden observatory of the iconic Umeda Sky Building for a panoramic view of Osaka city from atop. It's a DIY Takoyaki for lunch today! Free time at the Shinsaibashi Shopping Street. Included is Japanese Sukiyaki dinner tonight. Overnight Osaka.



APR 03 (MON) OSAKA/NARA/KYOTO (B/L/D)

Meet with guide and head to Nara, Japan's capital in 710 to visit the Todaiji Temple, home of one of the 2 Great Buddhas. Try letting your body go through a hole in the temple called the Buddha's Nostril to have a good after life. Lunch in a local restaurant and experience making sushi. Head to Kyoto. Although ravaged by wars, fires, and earthquakes during its eleven centuries as the imperial capital, Kyoto was spared from much of the destruction of World War II. Visit Kiyomizu Temple before having a stroll along Higashiyama District (hopefully to get a glimpse of the Geishas as they go to work). Japanese Chanko Nabe for dinner tonight. Overnight Kyoto



APR 04 (TUE) KYOTO/ ARASHIYAMA/NAGOYA (B/L/D)

Maximize our sightseeing of Kyoto and visit Arashiyama. Feast your sight as you stroll along the river to the sakura-clad gardens then to the invigorating Bamboo Forest. See Togetsukyo Bridge and the famous Kinkaku-Ji or Golden Pavilion, a Buddhist Temple with a garden complex that is an excellent example of the Muromachi Period – a classical age in Japanese garden design. This is considered one of the most photographed landmarks of the country. Lastly, head for Toyota Kaikan Museum. Located beside the Toyota Headquarters, one can view Toyota's latest models and new technologies plus an entertaining robot exhibition. Chicken set dinner and overnight in Nagoya tonight.



APR 05 (WED) NAGOYA / GUJO HACHIMAN / SHIZUOKA (B/L/D)

After breakfast proceed to Seki City's Monet Pond to see beautiful water lilies, Koi fish and colorful seasonal foliage in clear water. Proceed to Gujo Hachiman and experience hands on food replica making – certified enjoyable! To Shizuoka next and take the Nihondaira Ropeway to the Toshogu Shrine. Buffet dinner and overnight in Shizuoka tonight.

APRIL 06 (THU) SHIZUOKA/HAKONE / MT FUJI / OSHINO/LAKE KAWAGUCHI (B/L/D)

Enjoy a boatripe on Lake Ashi, take the Hakone Ropeway (cable car) then explore Owakudani Valley. Drive to Mt. Fuji 5th station (weather permitting). This well-proportioned cone-shaped mountain has been worshipped by the Japanese people since ancient time and is a well-known national symbol of Japan. See Oshino Hakkai Village before lunch in a local restaurant. Experience an onsen in our Ryokan tonight.

APR 07 (FRI) LAKE KWAGUCHI / GOTEMBA / YOKOHAM/ TOKYO (B/L/D)

Today we do some strawberry picking and tasting then visit Gotemba Premium Outlet. Then on to the port city of Yokohama and drive thru Minato Mirai 21. Visit a Ramen Museum and a Cup Noodle factory. Then experience a Shinkansen (bullet train) from Shin- Yokohama station to Shinagawa station. Upon arrival into Shinagawa station, walk over to hotel for check-in. Ramen dinner awaits.

APR 08 (SAT) TOKYO (B/L/D)

After breakfast visit Asakusa Kannon Temple and Nakamise shopping street where one can buy Japanese handcraft souvenirs. The Tokyo Sky Tree could be seen from here too. Japanese Grill Fish set for lunch. Proceed to Ueno Park for Sakura viewing (if blossom permits) and stroll along Ameyoko. See the Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building Observation deck & Shinjuku district. Have Japanese pork shabu shabu for dinner tonight.



APR 09 (SUN) (B/L/D)

Visit Meiji Shrine and Shibuya district. Drive past the Imperial Palace, residence of Japan's Emperor, the National Diet Building and the Tokyo Tower. Proceed to Tsukiji Outer Market for a chance to taste fresh seafood and fruits. We end the day with a stroll around Ginza district on our last night in Tokyo
